

The IVth Masters World Games were sponsored by Nike and the diving portion was held at the Tualatin Hills Aquatic Complex, Beaverton, Oregon, August 9-11, 1998. **Ron Piemonte** was Commissioner of Diving (meet director), **Tom Trapp** was head referee and **Lori Leach** was meet secretary and with a great staff ran the scoring table. Approximately 72 divers from around world attended this meet, run under FINA rules. The medals were truly gorgeous and worth the effort, not withstanding the the rather stiff \$200 entry fee, which otherwise probably kept a larger number of folks from participating, especially from the USA, what with our Masters Outdoor championships coming up in 10 days.
