Drawing on the precedence used for awarding the **Stauffer Awards** (coin and stamp sets), in that once one has won the set of Olympic Coins, they cannot win it a second time, I have decided to modify the criteria and formula so that any two persons cannot dominate the winning of these awards, as has been the case in the past. Therefore, once one has won the award two or more times in the past in a particular ten year age group, they cannot win it again until they move up to the next ten year age group, and then only twice, etc. I have computed the points for the top three place finishers in the past and this year. I have also asked the first and/or second place finishers for their permission to pass the awards to lower point finishers who have never won the awards before. John and Richard graciously agreed to pass the award to Tom, and Mary to Bonnie.
