

The 2014 (Spring) U.S. Masters National Invitational Diving Championships were held at the Northside ISD-Northside Swim Center, San Antonio, Texas, May 1-4, 2014. First time Novice divers are included, but this event is unofficial and records are not being kept. As usual, there were some close contests in various age groups.
