

The 2016 (Spring) U.S. Masters National Indoor Invitational Diving Championships were held at the YMCA of Central Florida, Orlando, FL, May 6-8, 2016, site of the 1998 Spring Indoor event. **Ron Kontura, Jr**, Masters Chairman and Meet Director. **Mike Brady**, Pool Manager; **Rowdy Gaines**, Aquatics Director, along with **DiveMeets.Com**. 82 registered, 80 divers participated. First time and previous novice divers are included, but this event is unofficial and records set are not being kept. Six World and four American Records were set. There were some very close contests. NOTES:

1. This **Novice** event is a continuing event. It was a first time event, voted on in 2013 at the Michigan Summer meet. It has not since been voted on as a regular event, therefore there will be no records set or kept for this event.
2. Some divers dived in both regular and novice events. See above.
3. This **Novice** event is to encourage new divers who otherwise could not compete in regular events. It has currently served its purpose and hopefully will encourage other divers to enter in future national championships.
4. Special medals were awarded for these **Novice** events.
5. 82 divers originally registered, but some otherwise did not show, for various reasons. There were some late deck entries, bringing the total competitors to 80.
6. Remaining events for 2016: Summer Nationals, Greensboro, NC, July 29-31. Olympic Games, Rio de Janeiro, Brazil; American Masters Games, August 26-September 4, Vancouver, Canada (diving is currently tentative).
7. As per a rule change in 2015, GM5 events for both men and women are now formatted at 5 dives instead of six starting in 2016.
